MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Peace and good!

As we contemplate our spiritual focus for 2023, it can be sometimes useful to look back at our early beginnings of faith formation. I recently reviewed an old notebook where I had written notes that inspired me. This was before I had discovered the Franciscans and the Secular Franciscan Order. I found a page with quotes that I used to refer to frequently. There are several about humility: Matthew 23:12 and Luke 14:10. There are others that are about detachment: Mark 4:25 and Luke 6:38. There is another by Frederich Nietzche who philosophizes on happiness. I include the quote here: For happiness, how little suffices for happiness! The least thing precisely, the gentlest thing, the lightest thing, a lizard's rustling, a breath, a wink, an eye glance – little maketh up the best happiness. Be still. And at the bottom of the page of that notebook, there is the Prayer of St. Francis, which I saw in the St. Joseph weekly bulletin before I even knew that the Friars were Third Order Regular.

Most certainly, I am in a different place in my life than when I assembled that notebook. There are different inspirations and spiritual practices that keep me grounded. Yet, the notes from an early stage of my faith formation are still very relevant.

As each of you think about rejuvenating your faith practices in 2023, pay attention to what energizes you these days. Keep it simple. If it appears to work for you today, stick with it. However, if some of your practices seem stale, you may want to reflect on your earlier motivations.

Look forward to another year of growth in our journey together as Secular Franciscans in 2023!
